- 191 **Daou Vineyards, Cabernet Sauvignon, Paso Robles**  
A rich, lavish, and full-bodied Paso Cabernet Sauvignon, that is both concentrated and powerful, yet light on its feet.
- 192 **Arrowood Sonoma Estate, Cabernet Sauvignon, Sonoma County**  
A lovely, Sonoma County cabernet, with layers of flavor, a velvety softness, and a smooth and luscious palate.
- 193 **Caterwaul, Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley**  
Superstar winemaker Thomas Brown has fashioned this most compelling wine, one that represents one of the greatest wine values in anywhere. Rich, lavish, and layered, with amazing length, and an incredibly polished finish.
- 194 **Jordan Vineyards, Cabernet Sauvignon, Alexander Valley, Sonoma County**  
Year in and year out, Jordan Vineyards Cabernets continue to deliver rich, ripe, and bold flavors, without the heaviness. This is a balanced wine, one that is produced with a French personality in mind.
- 195 **Caymus Vineyards, Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley**  
A Cabernet of luxurious opulence, richness, structure, and weight, with super-ripe fruit that lays over a plush and velvety texture.
- 196 **Quilt, Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley**  
A Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon of luxurious opulence, intense and explosive fruit, richness, structure and weight. Produced by winemaker Joseph Wagner.
- 197 **Silver Oak Wine Cellars, Cabernet Sauvignon, Alexander Valley, Sonoma County**  
A Classic Alexander Valley wine, with lush, ripe, and layered Cabernet fruit yet, balanced and made for food. “Life is a Cabernet.”
- 198 **Opus One, Napa Valley**  
A towering Masterpiece with extraordinary perfume, flawless balance, super-fine tannins, and serious length. A benchmark cabernet from the Napa Valley.

Greg Brewer is a rock star, and he produces some of the most profound and sought-after Pinot Noirs in America. This is a sexy and luscious wine, with an elegance and minerality that separates if from the pack.
- 208 **Elouan, Pinot Noir, Willamette Valley, Oregon**  
Sourced from a number of distinctive vineyard sites in the Willamette Valley, this is a soft, pretty, and seductive wine that is not about power, but elegance.
- 209 **Goldeneye Winery, Pinot Noir, Anderson Valley, Mendocino**  
The Mendocinos cool and maritime influence, produces pinot noirs of both elegance and power. This is a serious wine, one that will age gracefully for many years to come, but it still lovely to enjoy today.

This new property on Etna that is owned by the Gaja and Graci Families (who need no introduction), is now producing some inspiring wines. This is a pure, riveting, and minerally wine, with savory notes, a flowery personality, and a mouth-watering finish.
- 127 **Tormaresca, Chardonnay Puglia I.G.T**  
Wonderfully rich, and tropical Chardonnay, with solid structure, elegance, and minerality. A delicious wine, produced by the Iconic, Piero Antinori.
- 128 **Marchese Antinori, Cervaro della Sala, Chardonnay, Castello della Sala, Umbria IGT**  
One of Italy’s greatest Chardonnays with the richness, balance, and complexity, that wine aficionados search for. Stunning, Worldly, and awe-inspiring.

## CHARDONNAY

- 135 **Diatom, Chardonnay, Santa Barbara County**  
Crafted by super-star winemaker Greg Brewer, this is a knock out achievement in Chardonnay. This un-oaked masterpiece is absolutely delicious on the palate, with its rich, lush, and suave texture. Without a doubt, one of the Worlds top Chardonnay Values!
- 136 **Brewer-Clifton, Chardonnay, Santa Rita Hills, Santa Barbara**  
2022 Winemaker of the Year Greg Brewer has done it again, as he has crafted a sensational wine. His approach to chardonnay incorporates tradition with precision, resulting in honest and driven wines. The cool ocean influence of these extraordinary vineyards, showcase a unique saline quality, expressive of the place.
- 137 **Chalk Hill Vineyards, Chardonnay, Sonoma Coast**  
A rich, lavishly structured Chardonnay, with great intensity, concentration, purity and length. Produced by part-time Kauai resident, Bill Foley. Ring a bell?
- 138 **Patz & Hall, Chardonnay, Sonoma Coast**  
Patz & Hall has long been recognized, as one of the finest producers of Chardonnay in California. This wine with its intense personality, rich palate, and complex flavors, remains a standard for which many would like to emulate.
- 139 **Flowers, Chardonnay, Sonoma Coast**  
A wine that needs no introduction. A rich and finely textured Chardonnay masterpiece, from the cool and higher elevations in the Sonoma Coast.
- 140 **Gran Moraine, Chardonnay, Yamhill-Carlton, Willamette Valley, Oregon**  
Oregon Chardonnay at the highest level. Light and lithe on the palate, yet intense, and full throttled. Amazing minerality here, closer in many ways, to the Old World of Burgundy, France.
- 141 **Merryvale, Silhouette Chardonnay, Napa Valley**  
This Chardonnay captures the family’s vision of crafting an old-world style of white wine, from the famed Napa Valley. It is rich, full, and tropical, but with minerality, and an elegantly balanced and refined finish.
- 142 **William Fevre, Chablis “Champs Royaux” Burgundy, France**  
A textbook Chablis with its fresh and intense personality, lively acidity, and steely minerality, from some of the oldest limestone soils on the planet. A made for seafood kind of wine.
- 143 **Stag’s Leap Wine Cellars, “Karia” Chardonnay, Napa Valley**  
A rich, lavish, and intensely flavored Napa Valley Chardonnay, with a long, and palate coating richness. Produced by the iconic Tuscan Family, of Marchese Antinori.

## SAUVIGNON BLANC

- 145 **The Paring, Sauvignon Blanc, California**  
Defined by powerful fruit and balanced by mouth-watering freshness, this is an exotic, decadently textured, and electrically charged glass of sauvignon blanc. Produced by super-star winemaker Matt Dees, of Jonata Vineyards.
- 146 **Duckhorn Vineyards, Sauvignon Blanc, North Coast**  
A lush, vibrant, and yet elegant wine, with an enticing medley of tropical and citrus aromas. A touch of Sémillon to the blend adds depth and complexity.
- 147 **Dog Point, Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand**  
Wildly aromatic, New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc, with intense flavors, racy acidity, and a concentrated finish.
- 148 **Cloudy Bay, Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand**  
Arguably, one of the great Sauvignon Blancs of the World, and the benchmark of all New Zealand wines to follow. What separates this from others, is its richly layered texture, explosive aromatics, and its luxurious finish.

## OTHER WHITE WINE DISCOVERIES

- 150 **Reinhold Haart, Riesling Medium Dry, Mosel, Germany**  
A beautifully crafted German riesling, produced from arguably, one of the greatest Estate in the Mosel. These are rich and intense wines with lovely fruit, as well as the tell-tale, tart, tangy, and racy acidity.
- 151 **Birichino, Malvasia Bianco, Monterey**  
Birichino (naughty in Italian), is producing some of the most exciting wines, from the cool vineyards of Monterey. This is just a wonderfully aromatic white wine, one that laps from the glass with a flowery and perfumed nose of honeysuckle and orange blossoms yet, finished cool, light, and dry on the palate. One of the most food friendly wines on the planet.

## ROSATO (ROSÉ)

The world has recently discovered the virtues of dry Rosé wine, as the finest expressions are not only delicious and refreshing, but they can be amazing with a myriad of foods.

- 155 **Tormaresca Calafuria Rosato, Puglia**  
You are a sip away from the coastline of Puglia, with a delicately floral and deliciously refreshing rosé that will pair well with any of our dishes or simply, by itself.
- 156 **Frescobaldi, Tenuta Ammiraglia “Alìe” Rosé, Tuscany**  
An alluring, sensual, and absolutely delicious rosé that will pair well with anything on our menu. Its pale, pink color explodes on the nose with ripe peach and strawberry, yet it is soft, fine, and minerally.
- 157 **Château Peyrassol, Côtes de Provence Rose, France**  
Produced from a blend of 7 different grapes including Cinsault, Grenache, Syrah, Mourvedre, and Vermentino, this is a quintessential rose of Provence. Pale and pink in color, with a clean and fresh palate with a subtle hint of salinity from the sea.

## ITALIAN RED WINE DISCOVERIES

- Nowhere else in the world will you find such an array of uniquely local and regional red grape varieties, than Italy. From these many different grapes, there are wines with so many different personalities, that it would take a lifetime to experience all of them. Some of the most famous grapes are Sangiovese, which is the predominant grape grown in Tuscany and Nebbiolo, which produces the famed Barolo and Barbaresco wines of Piedmont. We encourage you to explore, discover, and get excited about everything Italy has to offer. Let the journey begin.
- 160 **Fattoria Del Cerro, Chianti Colli Senesi D.O.C.G.**  
A lovely and beautifully perfumed Chianti, with a vivid ruby red color, and a powerful yet soft palate. A lighter version, one that will pair with virtually any of our foods.
- 161 **Tenuta Di Arceno, Chianti Classico, Tuscany**  
A rich, powerful, and savory wine, produced from a blend of Sangiovese which brings the power, and Merlot which helps to soften and balance this worldly wine.
- 162 **Castello di Volpaia, Chianti Classico Riserva, Tuscany**  
This is a terrific Chianti. One with that combine richness and power, and a brilliant, classy, and sophisticated texture.
- 163 **Villa Antinori Chianti Classico DOCG Riserva, Tuscany**  
The inaugural vintage of this benchmark wine was in 1928, almost 100 years ago! Since then, little has changed. From one year to the next, this is a masterpiece. A Chianti with the depth of concentration, pedigree and breed, that all others hope to achieve. Riserva refers to the additional time that this wines spends in oak for added richness and complexity.
- 164 **Biondi-Santi, Rosso di Montalcino, Tuscany**  
Biondi-Santi is credited with producing the first Brunello di Montalcino, and it could be said that all other producers have been chasing them every since. This “Rosso” is produced from younger Sangiovese wines on the property so while it will not have the power and majesty of their Brunello, it will give you everything that you would want.
- 165 **Castello di Volpaia, IGT Toscana Rosso “Citto,” Tuscany**  
Citto (Italian for good little boy), is an artful blend of Sangiovese and Cabernet Sauvignon that has been fermented in stainless steel. Unlike the more savory wines of Chianti, this is a fruitier version, one of immediate gratification.
- 166 **Planeta, La Segreta Il Rosso, Sicily**  
Produced from primarily Nero d’Avola, Merlot, and Syrah, this is a fresh young wine with wild berry flavors, a ripe and fruity nose, and a soft, and lush palate.
- 167 **Castello di Volpaia, Prelius Cabernet Sauvignon, Maremma, Tuscany**  
Produced from 100% Cabernet Sauvignon and from 100% organic grapes, this is a rich, layered, and intense wine from the Tuscan Coast of Italy. A good value, and introduction into Italian Cabernet.
- 168 **Arcanum, Il Fauno Di Arcanum, Tuscany**  
A rich, lush, and voluptuously textured Bordeaux-styled blend, that is truly one of the greatest values in wine. Produced from a blend of Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon, and Petit Verdot, it’s akin to a classy Frenchman in a fitted, Italian suit.
- 169 **Tenuta dei Sette, Cieli ‘noi 4’ Bolgheri, Tuscany**  
Produced from a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Petit Verdot, and Cabernet Franc, and aged in Barriques for eight month, this is a wonderful Bordeaux Blend with an Italian personality. Ripe, rich, and multi-faceted on the palate.
- 170 **Arnaldo Caprai, “Collepiano” Sagrantino di Montefalco, Umbria**  
Produced by the Benchmark producer of the Sagrantino grape in Umbria, this is an inspiring wine that is definitely worth checking out. This is a powerful, yet elegant wine, with a nose redolent of black fruits, pepper, exotic spices, and a note of balsamic.
- 171 **IDDA, Etna Rosso, Sicily**  
IDDA means “she” in the Sicilian dialect, and it is a term that the locals affectionally use to define Mt.Etna. Produced from Nerello Mascalese, and Nerello Cappuccio grapes, this is a wonderfully concentrated, rich, and enveloping wine but yet, it is so soft and elegant on the palate.
- 172 **Marchese Antinori “Solaia,” Tuscany IGT 2019**  
Pure perfection in the glass and one of the most coveted and collectable wines in the World. Rated a perfect 100 pts. by the Wine Advocate, this is the stuff that dreams are made of. Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, and Sangiovese like you have never experienced it before.
- 173 **Feudo Montoni, “Lagnusa” Nero D’Avola, Sicily**  
The color is vivid and ruby red, and this is a wine about elegance over power. It delivers a wild and exotic nose of strawberries, and red fruits, and a soft, long, and delicate palate.
- 174 **Produttori del Barbaresco, Nebbiolo Langhe D.O.C. Piedmont**  
Nebbiolo is the grape that produces some of Italy’s greatest wines most notably, Barolo and Barbaresco. This is a terrific value, a wine that would give you much of what you would look for in either of those two wines, but at a fraction of the price.
- 175 **Prunotto, Barbaresco DOCG, Piedmont**  
Produced from 100% Nebbiolo grapes in a very classical style, this is a wine of elegance, and grace, yet power, structure, and concentration. It’s got a very long life ahead of it, but why wait?
- 176 **Cigliuti, Barbaresco “Serraboella” D.O.C.G. Piedmont**  
The wines from this high elevation, and “sweet spot” of a vineyard are perhaps more liken to their famous neighbors of Barolo. These are wines of tremendous depth and aromatic complexity, power and long life and above all, sheer enjoyment.
- 177 **Paulo Conterno, Barolo D.O.C.G. “Riva Del Bric” Piedmont**  
The Conterno name is legendary in Piedmont, and their Barolo wines are sensational. The Riva Del Bric bottlings are typically a bit more giving in their youth, so this will be a more elegantly structured wine (but still with robust body), with a beautiful garnet color, and a nose of wild cherries and rose petals.
- 178 **Prunotto Barolo “Bussia” DOCG, Piedmont**  
Ruby red in color, with striking garnet hues that are almost luminous in the glass. This is a wine of pedigree, complexity, and intense texture yet, sweet and silky tannins, great length, and persistence.
- 179 **Braida Barbera D’Asti“Montebruna,” Piedmont**  
Giacomo Bologna has long been one of the greatest producers of Barbera in all of Piedmont. This wine is absolutely delicious! With its beautiful purplish-red color, explosive aromatics, rich, full, and harmonious palate, this is a glass of wine that is not easy to put down.
- 180 **Pecchenino, San Luigi Dogliani Dolcetto, Piedmont**  
Wonderfully delicious, intriguing and alluring wine, with some power and yet, voluptuous fruit and a savory finish. Dolcetto translatesto “the little sweet one,” as it will typically have a fruitier personality then its more famous neighbors of Barolo and Barbaresco.
- 181 **Salvatore Molettieri, Taurasi “Cinque Querce,” Campania**  
Produced from the local Aglianico grape, the wines of Molettieri tower above all others. These are huge, dark, and intensely layered wines and one sip will indeed, leave a lasting impression. They are not for the faint of heart as their power and tannins, add to their masculinity. Enjoy them with rich foods, roasted meats, or the finest steaks.
- 182 **Righetti, Amarone della Valpolicella Classico “Capitel Roari,” Veneto**  
This is a distinctive Amarone with a classic and approachable style, where elegance prevails over power. It is complex, well balanced, and well-orchestrated. A relative value, with early accessibility, that will last for a decade.
